What is a MedsCheck?

A MedsCheck is a service performed by our pharmacists, in the pharmacy, and reviews all your medications. There is a focus on education and self-management, and we aim to identify any problems that you may be experiencing with your medicines. We also help you learn more about your medicines, help you to use your medicines effectively, and discuss ways to best store your medicines.

Why have a MedsCheck?

A MedsCheck will help you :

- ✓ minimise the risk of a misadventure with any of your medicine
- ✓ have a better understanding of all your medicines
- ✓ feel more confident that you are taking the right medicines at the right time
- ✓ ensure that your medicines are working for you
- ✓ think of the best way to store your medicines

How does a MedsCheck work?

Many people often find themselves on multiple medications to manage multiple conditions. Every year in Australia over 200,000 people are admitted to hospitals due to medication problems. At least half of these admissions could be avoided through better medication management.

A MedsCheck offers one-on-one time with one of our friendly pharmacists, in our private consulting rooms, and takes about 20-30 minutes. After the meeting our pharmacist will:

- produce a printed summary of all your regular medicines, including any over-the-counter or natural medicines
- produce a documented "Action Plan" that will help ensure you are taking the right medicine at the right time
- ensure that all your questions about your medicine have been answered
